note 2: There is no clear-cut distinction between Shrimps and Prawns. In several countries the commodity name Shrimps is used for the small species whereas the slightly larger ones are called Prawns. However, a species marked in certain regions of the world as "Prawn" may be called in the local English language in other areas a shrimp and visa versa, e.g., *Pandalus borealis* called Northern prawn or Deepwater prawn in the United Kingdom and the same species is named Pink shrimp in Canada.
